

New Hampshire Implementation -American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Program Title: **Weatherization**

Short Description: Weatherization funds for energy efficiency measures in low income households

ARRA Appropriation nationwide: \$5,000,000,000

Estimated New Hampshire Funds: \$23,218,594

Granting Agency: U.S. Department of Energy

Managing Agency: Office of Energy and Planning (“OEP”)

Status: Funding announced on 3/26/09.

Award Criteria: Existing weatherization provisions, with increase in eligibility to 200% of federal poverty guidelines (formerly 150%), and the maximum assistance per dwelling unit is increased from \$2,500 to \$6,500. ARRA, page 31-32.

New Hampshire must make certain energy related assurances to qualify for these funds.

Time Line for use: Awaiting federal guidance
