Program Title:           **State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance**

Short Description:       Funds used to for law enforcement purposes by the Attorney General's Office and sub-grants to State, County, and Municipal Law Enforcement programs.

ARRA Appropriation nationwide:   \$2,000,000,000

New Hampshire Funds:                         \$9,774,576

(\$3,520,821 is allocated directly to larger municipalities, see link below to view list)  
(\$6,253,755 is allocated to the State, of which approximately 55% is made available to programs benefiting smaller municipalities that do not receive direct funds)

Granting Agency:       U.S. Department of Justice

Managing Agency:    New Hampshire Attorney General's Office

**Status:**                   **Federal allocation announced.**

Award Criteria:        JAG grants are allocated based on a formula of population and violent crime statistics, in combination with a minimum allocation to ensure that each state and territory receives an appropriate share of funding. Sixty percent of the allocation is awarded to the state and 40 percent is set aside for units of local governments.
