

New Hampshire Implementation -American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Program Title: **Grants–In-Aid for Airports**

Short Description: Grants for discretionary airport-improvement projects for the procurement, installation and commissioning of runway incursion prevention devices and systems at airports

ARRA Appropriation nationwide: \$1,100,000,000

Estimated New Hampshire Funds: \$5,600,000

Granting Agency: Secretary of Transportation (Federal Aviation Administration)

Managing Agency: Department of Transportation

Status: Three aircraft parking apron projects have been granted (airports in Keene, Laconia, and Nashua) totaling \$3,886,920; one aircraft rescue and fire fighting vehicle has been bid (airport in Manchester).

Award Criteria: Priority within existing NHDOT programs

Time Line for use:

- Funds apportioned on March 9, 2009
- \$1M in funds allocated on March 24, 2009; \$4.6M in funds allocated on April 8, 2009
- 50% of funds must be placed under contract by June 17, 2009.
- 100% of funds must be placed under contract by February 16, 2010 while FAA intends to be at 100% no later than September 30, 2009.
- Any recovered funds must be re-obligated by Sept. 30, 2010, or they will be lost.
- Projects must be completed by February 17, 2011 (2 years).
