AUTOMATIC EXTENSION	If you pay 100% of the Business Enterprise Tax and Business Profits Tax determined to be due, by the due date of the tax you will be granted an automatic 7-month extension to file your New Hampshire returns WITHOUT filing this form. If you meet this requirement, you may file your New Hampshire Business Enterprise Tax and Business Profits Tax return up to 7 months beyond the original due date and you will not be subject to the failure to file penalty. Please note that an extension of time to file your returns is not an extension of time to pay the tax.
E-FILE	Make 100% of your payment on-line and you will not have to file this form. Log on to www.state.nh.us/revenue .
WHO MUST FILE	If you need to make an additional payment in order to have paid 100% of the tax determined to be due, you may e-file your payment or you may submit this form with payment or make an electronic payment by the original due date in order to be granted an extension of time to file your return. Do not file if the Net Balance Due is zero.
WHEN TO FILE	This form must be postmarked on or before the original due date of the return. Electronic payments must be made before midnight of the due date of the return.

REASONS FOR DENIAL	Applications for extension will be denied for reasons such as, but not limited to, the application was postmarked after the due date or the payment for 100% of the balance due shown on Line 5(c) above did not accompany this application or was not received electronically by the due date of the return.
