Saf-C 5914.01 Challenge Process

Those medical professionals set forth in Saf-C 5914.02, who are properly licensed by and in good standing with the State of NH, may challenge the First Responder or EMT-Basic National Registry examinations.

Saf-C 5914.02 Medical Professionals

The following medical professionals may challenge the National Registry examinations:

- (1) A registered nurse (RN)
- (2) A physician's assistant (PA)
- (3) A medical doctor (MD)
- (4) A doctor of osteopathy (DO)

Saf-C 5914.03 First Responder and EMT-Basic Challenge

In order to challenge the National Registry examination and become a nationally registered First Responder (FR) or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Basic, a medical professional shall:

- (1) Enroll in a First Responder or EMT-Basic Refresher Training Program (RTP);
- (2) Provide a legible copy of a current **NH** license/credentials at the RN, PA, MD or DO levels to the Division;
- (3) Successfully complete the appropriate level refresher training program process as set forth in Saf-C 5913.01 or Saf-C 5913.02.

Once the medical professional [is listed on the course completion roster for the refresher training program (RTP)] has met the requirements listed above and has been verified by the Division, he / she shall successfully complete the FR or EMT-Basic cognitive examination.

- (1) Successfully complete the FR or EMT-Basic Practical Examination; and
- (2) Successfully complete the FR or EMT-Basic Computer-Based Test (CBT)

The Division shall communicate to the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) that the medical professional shall be eligible to apply for [licensure] certification at the [NREMT-B] appropriate level.
