ALS Testing Information for New Hampshire Students

To be eligible for ALS testing, all New Hampshire-trained ALS candidates must meet ALL eligibility criteria and be authorized by Division of Fire Standards and Training and Emergency Medical Services (FST&EMS).

- Scheduling may take up to four weeks after ALS program completion to ensure that all agency testing applications, criteria and other requirements are met
- ALS testing registration must be complete no less than three weeks prior to the Scheduled examination date
- By the registration deadline candidates must have successfully completed a FST&EMS Authorized ALS Training Program
- A final "Course Completion Roster" from the course instructor/coordinator must be on file with FST&EMS by the .
- Contact BTA for testing and eligibility criteria at least four weeks prior to test date at 603.648.6467 or www.beckertraining.com
- Contact NREMT for testing and eligibility criteria at least four weeks prior to test date at 614.888.4484 or www.nremt.org
- No candidates will be permitted to test if not approved prior to the examination registration deadline by NH FST&EMS
- Candidates not completing all requirements in the time frame noted will need to schedule for the following months examination.
