

CHANGES AND UPDATES TO USING TEMSIS WITH VARIOUS INTERNET BROWSERS

CHROME:

In September, 2015(Google has no specific start date in September), Google Chrome will no longer support Microsoft's Silverlight Plug-In. As a result, you will not be able to access TEMSIS using Google Chrome. You will be able to utilize Google Chrome again starting in January, 2016, as TEMSIS Elite will no longer need to use Silverlight (Woo Hoo!).

FIREFOX:

No Issues, this is a good replacement for Chrome and the only alternative for Mac users to enter TEMSIS reports until the TEMSIS Elite Transition in January.

INTERNET EXPLORER (IE):

This also still works fine*, recommended version is IE 10 or higher. TEMSIS will soon not support IE 8, and IE 9 will have limited functionality with Elite. (*Several Internet Option settings can cause issues, but are easily changed to resolve the issues)

Windows 10/EDGE:

The default browser for Windows 10 is called "Edge". It is separate from Internet Explorer. Windows Microsoft Edge, ironically, does not support Microsoft's Silverlight. Therefore, when using Windows 10, you must utilize either Internet Explorer (which still comes with Windows 10) or Firefox. *Note the Icons for Edge and IE are very similar:*



This icon is **for Internet Explorer** 11 within Windows 10 and **still supports** Silverlight/TEMSIS.



This icon is for an app called "**Edge**" and is the default browser in Windows 10. It **does not** support Silverlight/TEMSIS.
