This **3-day course** trains emergency response supervisors and managers in the skills necessary to effectively plan for and manage a WMD (CBRNE) / terrorism incident by applying the all-hazards command and management structures found in the National Incident Management System (NIMS) - specifically, the Incident Command System (ICS), Multi-Agency Coordination Systems, and Public Information Systems. The IM/UC (MGT 313) course complies with the NIMS National Standard Curriculum Training Development Guidance of October, 2005 and has been deemed to be both "ICS-300 compliant and equivalent training" by the DHS Office of Grants and Training (G&T) in conjunction with the DHS NIMS Integration Center (NIC).

Minimum class size is 50 students. (Minimum of 36 students must be met for class to run.)
