

Applicants are encouraged to read the synopsis below, this outlines the Marine Patrol Bureau's written examination:

You will be allowed up to three (3) hours to complete this examination consisting of 100 multiple-choice questions. The written examination is designed to measure participants' possession of the following job-related knowledge, skills and abilities: knowledge of: basic marine and boating terminology; general / basic law enforcement procedures, court procedures, legal terminology, public relations principles and practices; writing techniques including general vocabulary, proper sentence structure, grammar, spelling, etc.; basic mathematics including addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, decimals, fractions and the computation of percentages; ability to: read and comprehend law enforcement related passages and other written materials; accept supervision and training and to use proper judgment in the resolution of law enforcement related incidents.
