The NH Veterans Home, the long-term home of choice for veteran residents and caring staff, is accepting applications for the following positions, both full and part-time (all shifts) in our Resident Care Services department.

REGISTERED NURSES

RN I (LG 19) \$20.23-\$23.85/hr

Provide general nursing duties in the care and treatment of residents and compile and report information/observations concerning residents with individualized treatment programs.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from a recognized nursing program. Experience is limited to that required for registration and current NH license as RN.

RN II: (LG 21) \$21.97-\$25.87/hr

Provide general or specialized nursing duties in the care and treatment of residents by applying professional nursing standards and making recommendations on health care work methods and treatment.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from a recognized nursing program with either affiliate or postgraduate courses and clinical nursing experience. One year of experience as an RN in similar setting and current NH license as an RN.

RN III: (LG 23) \$23.85-\$28.34/hr

Provide care and treatment for residents, with responsibility for administration of medication, comprehensive medical treatment planning, and/or ongoing supervision and training of subordinate nursing staff.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from a recognized nursing program with either affiliate or postgraduate courses and clinical experience. Two years of experience as an RN in similar setting and current NH license as an RN. **Special requirements:** Must be certified by the American Nurses Association or an org. recognized by the ANA in a specialty that is consistent with the job accountabilities and appropriate to NHVH, i.e. Gerontological Nurse, etc.

LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES

LPN I: (LG 16) \$17.96-\$21.05/hr

Provide nursing services for residents with responsibility for administering treatment and/or medication and applying procedures to safeguard life and health.

Min. qualifications: Completion of a recognized school of practical nursing approved by the State Board of Nursing Education and Nurse Registration. No experience required other than that obtained through required training. Must possess current NH license as a practical nurse or temporary permit issued by the NH Board of Nursing Education and Nurse Registration pending the results of the licensing examination.

LPN II: (LG 18) \$19.45-\$22.87/hr Must have three years experience and NFLPN Certification.

LICENSED NURSING ASSISTANTS

LNA TRAINEE: (LG 7) \$10.70-\$12.44/hr

Provide quality direct care and related support services for geriatric and/or psychiatrically impaired residents, including assistance in activities of living and maintaining a safe and clean environment.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from HS, GED or its equivalent. No experience required pending completion of all required written and physical components of the Certified Nursing Assistant training program approved by the NH Board of Nursing and current NH license.

NURSING ASSISTANT I: (LG 9) \$11.53-\$13.37/hr

provide quality direct care and related support services for geriatric and/or psychiatrically impaired residents, including assistance in activities of living and maintaining a safe and clean environment.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from HS, GED or its equivalent. Four months experience as a Nursing Assistant Trainee at NHVH with subsequent licensure as Nursing Assistant, or NH licensed as a Nursing Assistant with four months experience.

NURSING ASSISTANT II: (LG 11) \$12.44-\$14.45/hr

Assist in supervising and provide quality direct care services for geriatric and/or psychiatrically impaired residents, including assisting professional staff in providing motivation, recreation and learning activities.

Min. qualifications: Graduation from HS, GED or its equivalent. Two years of experience as a licensed Nursing Assistant. Current NH license as LNA required.

NURSING ASSISTANT III – MNA licensed only*: (LG 14) \$13.92-\$16.23/hr

Supervise and provide direct care services for assigned long-term geriatric residents, including performing medication administration and other para-professional work such as counseling with residents and acting as liaison between the hospital and community.

Min. qualifications: Associate's degree in social sciences or human services OR a high school diploma plus 18 credit hours in the field of social services or human services. Two years experience as an LNA and current license as a Medication Nursing Assistant (MNA)* is required for the LNA III position.
