Emelia Galdieri Sworn-in as Deputy Bank Commissioner

Concord, NH - Emelia A.S. Galdieri of Chichester, NH was sworn in this morning to serve as New Hampshire's Deputy Bank Commissioner. The event took place in the Governor and Executive Council Chambers in the New Hampshire State House before a group of family members and Banking Department co-workers.

Ms. Galdieri previously served as the department's Legal Counsel and, prior to that, as a department hearings examiner. Before joining the Banking Department Ms. Galdieri served as Senior Law Clerk in the New Hampshire Superior Court.

Emelia Galdieri received a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of New Hampshire in 2004 and a Juris Doctorate from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2010. She is admitted to practice law by the New Hampshire Bar, the Massachusetts Bar and by the Federal District Court for the District of New Hampshire.

"During her years spent leading the Banking Department legal team Ms. Galdieri has gained a thorough understanding of the financial service industries we supervise," said Bank Commissioner Jerry Little.

"She is a strong defender of state consumers, and makes sure their interests come first, but she also understands the issues and challenges facing financial institutions today and the rules and regulations we ask them to comply with. Emelia was a central part of the group that recently recodified all state laws under department jurisdiction and she also lead the analysis of all department rules recently requested by Governor Chris Sununu. She has excellent leadership skills, a well-balanced approach to problem solving and the experience and talent we need to continue moving the Banking Department forward," Commissioner Little concluded.
