9 Default Judgment

10 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department  
 11 ("Department") issued an Order to Cease and Desist ("Order") against  
 12 Respondent e Payday Loan (a/k/a e-payday-loan.com) ("Respondent E-Payday")  
 13 on May 10, 2012 via Registered Mail. Respondent E-Payday received the Order  
 14 at the Ukiah, California address on May 31, 2012. The Order delivered to  
 15 the Murray, Utah address was returned as not deliverable as addressed and  
 16 unable to forward. Respondent E-Payday failed to request a hearing or reach  
 17 a settlement with the Department on or before July 2, 2012 (which is over  
 18 thirty days from the May 31, 2012 delivery date) as required to avoid  
 19 Default.

20 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 21 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondent
- 22 E-Payday on July 3, 2012;
- 23 2. The allegations contained in the May 10, 2012 Order to Cease and
- 24 Desist are hereby deemed true;
- 25 3. Respondent E-Payday shall immediately pay to the Department an
