



NEW HAMPSHIRE BANKING DEPARTMENT ORDER

RE: Delegation to Hearings Officer

WHEREAS, pursuant to RSA 383:7-a, I, the New Hampshire Bank Commissioner (“Commissioner”) may delegate to Department deputies, assistants, examiners or employees the exercise or discharge in the Commissioner’s name of any power, duty or function except rulemaking power; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RSA 383:7-a, III, the delegation of duties shall be in writing and state an effective date; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby DELEGATE:

- I. Effective June 17, 2014, Andrew Eills as Presiding Officer to preside over the Department’s Adjudicative Hearing in Docket No. 12-308, In the Matter of: Cash Call, Inc., John Paul Reddam, President and CEO of CashCall, Inc., and WS Funding, LLC.
- II. Effective June 17, 2014, Andrew Eills, as Hearings Officer to exercise or discharge the following powers, duties or functions of the Commissioner in the Commissioner’s name over any other adjudicative matter to which he may be assigned:
 1. To schedule and hold Adjudicative Hearings for the Banking Department;
 2. To schedule and hold pre-hearing conferences related to the Adjudicative Hearings, by request of the parties or sua sponte;
 3. To issue decisions on non-dispositive motions that arise in Adjudicative Hearings (except that the delegation shall not include any determinations under RSA 383:10-b that the publication of records of investigations and reports of examinations serves the ends of justice and the public advantage);
 4. To submit to the Commissioner proposed decisions on the Adjudicative Hearings and any dispositive motions, which shall include:
 - i. Statements of the issues presented;
 - ii. Summaries of the evidence received;
 - iii. Proposed findings of fact and rulings of law; and
 - iv. Proposed orders.
- III. Such delegation shall be in effect through June 16, 2015, or until this delegation is revoked or Attorney Eills is no longer engaged by the Department, whichever event should occur first.
