**Motion to Withdraw Entry of Default Judgment**

Now comes the State of New Hampshire Banking Department, respectfully requesting that the Bank Commissioner withdraw the Entry of Default Judgment in the above-captioned matter. In support thereof, the Department states as follows:

1. The Department issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the respondent, Cash Web USA on June 12, 2013.
2. The Order to Cease and Desist notified the respondent of its right to request a hearing within 30 calendar days of receipt of the Order.
3. The respondent failed to request a hearing within 30 calendar days of receipt of the order.
4. Subsequently, the Department entered Default Judgment in the matter on July 25, 2013.
5. The Department and the respondent have agreed to resolve this matter with a Consent Order entered into on 12/11/13.
6. The petitioner submits this Motion with the assent of the respondent.

Wherefore, the petitioner respectfully requests that the Commissioner of the Banking Department:

- A. Withdraw the Entry of Default Judgment in the above-captioned matter; and
- B. Grant any other just and proper relief.
