**SUPPLEMENT TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire Banking Department (“Department”) and the Bank Commissioner (“Commissioner”) and supplements the Order to Show Cause issued June 26, 2015 against Respondents, White Mountain Carriage Company, LLC d/b/a Suzuki of Manchester d/b/a Gold Street Autocenter (“White Mountain”) and Arrien L.C. Schiltkamp, individually and as owner of White Mountain.

1. On June 26, 2015, the Department issued an Order to Show Cause why White Mountain’s retail seller license should not be revoked for violating RSA 361-A:10-c, I, RSA 361-A:11, VII, RSA 361-A:11, VIII, and RSA 361-A:3, I-a (e), (g) and (h).

2. Beginning on or before October 6, 2015, Respondents have ceased to engage in the business of a retail seller.

3. The Department has documented that there have been no vehicles for sale on the lot, no employees in the building and that the White Mountain business has otherwise been vacant since at least October 6, 2015.

4. Pursuant to RSA 361-A:2-a, I(a), Respondents were obligated to surrender the license within fifteen calendar days of ceasing to engage in the business of a retail seller.

5. Respondents have failed to surrender White Mountain's retail seller license.

6. Pursuant to RSA 361-A:2, II, failure to comply with the surrender provisions "shall be cause for denial of future license applications and the imposition of penalties under RSA 361-A:11."

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, in addition to the orders enumerated in the Order to Show Cause dated June 26, 2015, Respondents shall immediately surrender White Mountain's license to operate as a retail seller;
