**ORDER ON MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING**

**ORDER**

**I. Introduction**

The State of New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order for Immediate Suspension and Order to Show Cause for Revocation and Penalties ("Order") against Mike's Affordable Auto, LLC (d/b/a Mike's Affordable Auto and d/b/a Mike's Affordable Auto 2) and Michael Alan Albert (collectively, "Respondents"), on September 25, 2019. A hearing was scheduled for October 8, 2019. On October 4, 2019, Respondents filed a Motion to Continue Hearing ("Motion to Continue"), to which the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") objected on October 7, 2019. A Prehearing Status Conference was held on October 7, 2019 at 12 PM to see if the Parties could agree to a continuance. An agreement was not reached. As such, the Presiding Officer issues this ruling on the Motions.

**II. Order**


Respondents' Motion to Continue is granted in part. The hearing shall be continued to November 13, 2019 at 10:00 AM, provided that the Respondents produce a written statement

expressly waiving their right to a hearing within ten working days of the Show Cause under RSA 541-A:30, III. The written waiver shall be sent via electronic mail to the Presiding Officer (PresidingOfficer@banking.nh.gov) no later than 4:30 PM on October 7, 2019. If such waiver is not received, the hearing will not be continued and shall commence as scheduled, on October 8, 2019 at 10 AM. If such waiver is received, the Presiding Officer will issue a revised Notice of Hearing reflecting the new hearing date.

The immediate suspension of Respondents' retail seller license remains in full effect through any continuances granted by the Presiding Officer.
