AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT by and between the New Hampshire Banking Department (“the Department”) and Barrington Capital Corporation (BCC), with a principal place of business at 5000 Birch St., Newport Beach, CA.

WHEREAS, the Department enforces the provisions of RSA 397-A governing the requirements of licensure for Mortgage Bankers.

WHEREAS, BCC acknowledges it violated 397-A:11 by its failure to submit examination materials in a timely manner.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, representations, and agreements contained herein, the Department and BCC agrees as follows;

1. BCC owes the Department a fine pursuant to RSA 397-A:11 in the amount of \$2350.00 for being 47 days late in their submission. The fine to be paid immediately.
2. BCC agrees that any subsequent violations of law pertaining to its Mortgage Banker activities shall be grounds for further action being taken against it.
3. BCC agrees that it will not deny the factual basis for this Agreement to which it has stipulated above and will not give conflicting statements about such facts or its involvement in the stipulated facts.
4. BCC agrees that it will cease all mortgage activity until such time as it obtains licensure from the Department.
5. Violations of the Agreement shall constitute sufficient grounds for license denial, suspension or revocation or initiation of administrative action that may result in the imposition of fines for unlicensed activity as acknowledged above.
