Motion to Amend Default Judgment

Now Comes James Shepard, Petitioner in this cause, and moves to amend the Order to Show Cause and for cause states as follows:

1. The Commissioner issued an Order to Show Cause against the Respondent on April 27, 2007. The Staff Petition incorporated in the order included leave to amend.
