9 Amended Default Judgment

10 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department  
 11 ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause against the Respondent Beech  
 12 Street Auto Wholesalers LLC ("Respondent Beech Street Auto") and Respondent  
 13 Thomas V. Sanuth ("Respondent Sanuth") on June 1, 2009 via U.S. Certified  
 14 Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order to Show Cause was returned to the  
 15 Department on June 30, 2009 and the Commissioner took service on July 9,  
 16 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from July 9, 2009 to request a  
 17 hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The Respondents failed  
 18 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before  
 19 August 8, 2009 (which is thirty days from July 9, 2009) as required to avoid  
 20 Default.

21 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 22 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against  
 23 Respondents on August 9, 2009;  
 24 2. The allegations contained in the June 1, 2009 Order to Show Cause are  
 25 hereby deemed true;

- 1 3. Respondent Beech Street Auto shall immediately pay to the Department  
2 an administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 361-A in the  
3 amount of \$2,500.00;
- 4 4. Respondent Sanuth shall immediately pay to the Department an  
5 administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 361-A in the amount  
6 of \$2,500.00;
- 7 5. Respondent Beech Street Auto shall immediately pay to the Department  
8 the outstanding exam invoice totaling \$500.00;
- 9 6. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally  
10 liable; and
- 11 7. Respondent Beech Street Auto's license is hereby revoked.
