9 Default Judgment

10 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department  
 11 ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against the  
 12 Respondents Deocap Corporation ("Respondent Deocap"), Neill J. Sullivan  
 13 ("Respondent Sullivan") and William A. Raney ("Respondent Raney") on January  
 14 16, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order was  
 15 returned to the Department as "Unclaimed."

16 The Commissioner accepted service of the Order on behalf of the above  
 17 named Respondents on March 24, 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days  
 18 from March 24, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the  
 19 Department. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a  
 20 settlement with the Department on or before April 23, 2009 (which is thirty  
 21 days from March 24, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

22 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 23 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against  
 24 Respondents on April 24, 2009;  
 25 2. The allegations contained in the Order hereby deemed true;
