9 Default Judgment

10 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department
 11 ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause against Respondent Maine
 12 Capital Mortgage LLC ("Respondent Maine Capital") and Respondent Shawn P.
 13 Lyden ("Respondent Lyden") (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on July
 14 7, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order to Show
 15 Cause was returned to the Department on July 20, 2009 and the Commissioner
 16 took service on August 25, 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from
 17 August 25, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the
 18 Department. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a
 19 settlement with the Department on or before September 24, 2009 (which is
 20 thirty days from August 25, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

21 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 22 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against
 23 Respondents on September 24, 2009; and
 24 2. The allegations contained in the January July 7, 2009 Order to Show
 25 Cause are hereby deemed true; and

- 1 3. Respondent Maine Capital shall immediately pay to the Department an
2 administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount
3 of \$2,500.00; and
- 4 4. Respondent Lyden shall immediately pay to the Department an
5 administrative fine for two (2) violations of RSA Chapter 397-A in the
6 amount of \$5,000.00; and
- 7 5. Respondent Maine Capital shall immediately pay to the Department the
8 outstanding examination invoice totaling \$500.00;
- 9 6. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally
10 liable; and
- 11 7. Respondent Maine Capital's license is hereby revoked.
