10 Default Judgment

11 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department  
 12 ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against Respondent  
 13 UMS, LLC (d/b/a Unique Mortgage Solutions and d/b/a 1<sup>st</sup> Mortgage Solutions)  
 14 ("Respondent UMS") and Respondent Alexander Ramirez ("Respondent Ramirez")  
 15 (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on July 15, 2009 via U.S. Certified  
 16 Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order to Show Cause was returned to the  
 17 Department on August 20, 2009 and the Commissioner took service on August  
 18 25, 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from August 25, 2009 to  
 19 request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The  
 20 Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the  
 21 Department on or before September 24, 2009 (which is thirty days from August  
 22 25, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

23 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 24 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against  
 25 Respondents on September 24, 2009; and
