15 The Commissioner issued A Cease and Desist Order ("Order") against
 16 Mortgage Protection Services, Processing Center, P.O. Box 661028, Arcadia,
 17 California 91066-9812 on October 14, 2008. The Order was amended on November
 18 7, 2008 to include identified Respondents LeadSystems, Inc. and Tom Hoover
 19 ("Respondents Lead Systems"). The Respondents received the Order via U.S.
 20 Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested on November 13, 2008. None of the
 21 above named Respondents requested a hearing or reached a settlement with the
 22 New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") within thirty days as
 23 required to avoid a Default.

24 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 25 1. By operation of law, a Default Judgment was entered against each of
 the above named Respondents on December 13, 2008;

- 4. Respondent Tom Hoover shall immediately pay to the Department \$2,500.00 individually (\$2,500.00 jointly and severally)for violation of RSA 384:67;
- 5. Failure to abide by this Default Judgment may result in civil and/or criminal penalties.
