10 Default Judgment

11 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department
 12 ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against Respondent
 13 Express Mortgage Corporation ("Respondent Express Mortgage") and Respondent
 14 Mark P. Stanton ("Respondent Stanton") (collectively hereinafter
 15 "Respondents") on July 9, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt
 16 requested. The Respondents received and signed for the Order on July 18,
 17 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from July 18, 2009 to request a
 18 hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. On August 4, 2009, the
 19 Department mailed the Respondents a written acknowledgment to a verbal
 20 settlement agreement, wherein Respondents agreed to pay a lump sum of
 21 \$2,835.00. The Respondents have not made any payments to date nor signed
 22 the settlement agreement, which they received via U.S. Certified Mail Return
 23 Receipt requested on August 11, 2009. The Respondents failed to request a
 24 hearing or reach a formal and written settlement with the Department on or
 25 before August 17, 2009 (which is thirty days from July 18, 2009) as required
