



## **Information about Van-Accessible Parking**

### **What's the difference between a regular accessible parking space and a van-accessible parking space?**

In New Hampshire, a van-accessible parking space has an 8' access aisle. This is 3 feet larger than standard accessible parking access aisles.

### **Why have a van-accessible parking space?**

Van-accessible parking spaces accommodate larger vehicles, vehicles with ramps, lifts, or individuals who need extra room to maneuver safely.

### **Can only vans park in a van-accessible space?**

It is acceptable for anyone with a valid accessible plate or placard to park in a van-accessible parking space. Although, it is considerate to only use the space you need. If you don't need the extra space, save it for someone who does.

### **What else should I consider?**

Accessible parking etiquette relies on your good judgment. Consider leaving the van-accessible parking space for ramp or lift-equipped vehicles, larger vehicles, and for those who need the extra access aisle space. Whichever parking space you choose, always remember to keep access aisles free and clear of obstructions.
