GCD ANNOUNCES RELOCATION OF CONCORD OFFICE TO 54 REGIONAL DRIVE, STE 5

Concord, NH—Today Chuck Saia announced that it is official that the Governor's Commission on Disability has relocated to 54 Regional Drive, Concord, NH. With the approval of the Governor & Council, the new leased location is a sublet of Personnel and Bureau of Education's training space, whose intended use was altered due to the impact of Covid-19.

With the GCD and NH Personnel side-by-side neighbors, this is an opportunity for both departments to strengthen their collaborative ties and allow both to better serve clientele and the business needs of the State.

With the Governor & Council's approval at the August 26th meeting and the steady efforts of the Administrative Services, the move into the centrally located facility is complete.

"The GCD has embraced this change from the very beginning," said GCD Executive Director Saia. "To know that the vacated Philbrook Building will be utilized to better serve the mental health community and that the new space occupancy assists a NH state agency use space economically, it is truly a win-win."
