ELIMINATING EMPLOYMENT BARRIERS (FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES)

Concord, NH —Eliminating barriers of employment for those with disabilities is the daily task of the Client Assistance Program, also known as CAP.

“Finding a job is incredibly difficult even with all the tools on your side. For someone with a disability, it can be hard to know even where to start,” according to Lorrie J. Ripley who operates CAP.

“I get calls all the time from individuals who just don't even know where to start. I tell them that they don't have to figure everything out by themselves. That's where our conversation begins.”
