STABLE NH's Enrollment Increases as Word Spreads through Collaboration and Social Media

Concord, NH--Today Chuck Saia, executive director of the Governor's Commission on Disability, announced that total enrollment in the [STABLE NH](#) savings and investment plan for those with disabilities is growing. This game changer program for New Hampshire went live in December and has continued from day one to increase in participation.

"Word about STABLE NH has spread thanks to social media and collaboration with advocacy groups who have extended invitations for in-person presentations and question and answer sessions. With zero dollars earmarked for marketing, we have had to be creative," commented Saia.

As co-administrators of STABLE NH, NH State Treasurer Bill Dwyer and Saia have seized the opportunity to share with a variety of audiences how the plan works and how it allows for those who are eligible to save money without losing their SSI or Medicaid benefits.

"Collaboration and partnering is critical to the success of STABLE NH.. Recording a podcast for [Family Voices](#) with Project Director Silvia Pelletier and Project Coordinator Jennifer Pineo was one of our first outreaches. Coming up on Tuesday, Feb. 13th, is a webinar, hosted by Community Support network, Inc. ([CSNI](#)) where Bill and I will be able to reach another audience. Sometimes I sound passionate about this program and it is because I know it's not a numbers game—it's about offering a better tomorrow for those with disabilities."
