STABLE NH Plan Showcased in National Webinar Series

Concord, NH—Today Chuck Saia announced that the ABLE National Resource Center (ABLE NRC) will be showcasing STABLE Account Plans as part of its series of webinars on "ABLE Program Spotlight."

The series will focus on ways to maximize ABLE Accounts and begins Wednesday, May 22, 2019— 2pm to 3:15pm ET.

STABLE Account Plans are comprised of a 12-state partnership. New Hampshire's ABLE program, STABLE NH, is part of the STABLE family and is co-administered by NH State Treasurer Bill Dwyer and Governor's Commission on Disability's Executive Director Saia.

The overall objective of the series is to provide guidance on how to get the most out of an ABLE Account, and to offer a better understanding of how investment options of a STABLE Account can work best for you.

"Bill and I have been able to meet advocate groups and agencies throughout the Granite State over the last 15 months and address many of these same topics," said Saia. "This webinar is one more tool available to spread the word about STABLE NH, a financial resource that has already touched the lives of over 200 account enrollees in New Hampshire."

The panel will be joined by Ohio's STABLE Account Operations Manager Thomas Hatch and Deputy Director Doug Jackson.
