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US 4 REHABILITATION WORK IN BOSCAWEN-CONCORD-CANTERBURY
PART OF BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT OVER MERRIMACK RIVER

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces construction work is expected to begin the week of April 18, 2005 on the rehabilitation of a two-mile section of US Route 4 in Boscawen, Concord and Canterbury. This project will take place on US 4 between River Road in Boscawen and Boyce Road in Concord.

Motorists should expect lane closures and traffic shifts between April 18 and June 1. Uniformed officers will assist drivers through the work zone.

The road work is part of a project that included the construction of a new US 4 bridge over the Merrimack River. The new bridge was opened to traffic on September 30, 2004.

Beck and Belucci, of Franklin, New Hampshire is the general contractor for the \$10.9 million road improvement and bridge replacement project. The project's final completion date is July 2005.
