PAVING WORK ON NH 101 IN TEMPLE, PETERBOROUGH AND DUBLIN
WILL REQUIRE ALTERNATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC FOR UP TO SIX DAYS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces paving work is scheduled to get underway this week on two sections of NH Route 101 in the towns of Temple, Peterborough and Dublin.

Paving is set to begin on Tuesday, July 26 on a seven-mile stretch of NH 101 from the Temple-Wilton town line to Lookout Hill Road in Peterborough. That segment is expected to take five to six workdays to complete. A separate segment of NH 101 set for paving is approximately eight-tenths of a mile in Dublin from West Lake Road to Old Harrisville Road. This segment is expected to take one day to complete.

Motorists should anticipate one-way alternating traffic controlled by flaggers between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm during the paving work periods. Some delays can be expected.
