**OVERHEAD SIGN IMPROVEMENTS ON
INTERSTATE 95 AT THE HAMPTON TOLL PLAZA
WILL REQUIRE OCCASIONAL LANE CLOSURES**

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces advanced overhead sign work, including the installation of additional E-ZPass signs, will begin on Tuesday, February 21, 2006 at the Hampton Tolls on Interstate 95.

This work is expected to take approximately one week to complete. In the event of inclement weather, this timeframe will be extended.

Motorists traveling on Interstate 95 during this time period should expect occasional daytime and nighttime lane closures in both directions. Variable message boards and cones will alert motorists and guide them through the work zone.

Similar work was recently completed at the Bedford Tolls on the Everett Turnpike and at the Hooksett Tolls on Interstate 93.
