CANAAN-DORCHESTER PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
PROPOSED REPAIRS TO 2.8 MILES OF NH ROUTE 118

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a combined Public Officials/Public Informational Meeting will be held Tuesday, March 7, 2006 to discuss planned repairs to 2.8 miles of NH Route 118 in Canaan and Dorchester.

This paving work is necessary due to flooding that occurred from past rainstorm events. The project begins 3,000 feet north of North Lary Road in Canaan and proceeds north 2.8 miles to a point 2,000 feet north of the Canaan-Dorchester Town line.

The purpose of the March 7 public meeting is to presents citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit input. It will be held at the Canaan Fire Station, 62 NH 118, in Canaan, New Hampshire, beginning at 7:00 pm.
