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WORK BEGINS ON US 3 INTERSECTION PROJECT IN TILTON
4-WAY SIGNALIZED INTERSECTION AT CLARK ROAD/TOWN LINE PLAZA

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces construction work is underway in Tilton on the reconstruction of the US Route 3 intersection of Clark Road and Town Line Plaza.

This project will involve moving the intersection east to the other side of the Movie Gallery video store and realigning the Clark Road "Y" approach to make a four-way signalized intersection. The new signal will be synchronized with the existing signal at the Shop N Save/Rite Aid intersection.

The Route 3 work begins approximately at the Franklin/Tilton town line (Shop N Save intersection) and proceeds east approximately one-half mile to the Dairy Queen restaurant. The project also includes removal of concrete slab and road reconstruction, drainage, curbing, sidewalks and landscaping.

Two-way traffic will be maintained as much as possible during the project. One-way alternating traffic controlled by flaggers may be used during low traffic volume periods. Variable message boards will alert motorists that they are approaching a work zone.

F.L. Merrill Construction of Pembroke, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$1.7 million project, which has a final completion date of September 22, 2006.
