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I-93 PAVEMENT AND BRIDGE WORK IN CONCORD-CANTERBURY
REHABILITATION OF 4.5 MILES BETWEEN EXITS 17 AND 18

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces work is scheduled to begin later this week on the rehabilitation of pavement and bridges on 4.5 miles of Interstate 93 in Concord and Canterbury.

The pavement work includes both the northbound and southbound lanes between Exits 17 and 18, and work on the Exit 17 northbound off-ramp and southbound on-ramp. The bridge work consists of rehabilitation of the Exit 17 southbound on-ramp bridge, and rehabilitation of various bridge joints on I-93 from Canterbury to Woodstock.

There will be lane closures to perform this work, but they will be limited to not interfere with peak traffic times. Night work is a possibility.

Pike Industries, Inc. of Belmont, New Hampshire is the contractor for the \$3.34 million projects, which has final completion date of September 1, 2006.
