BRIDGE PAINTING ON NH ROUTE 103 IN WARNER
WILL REQUIRE SINGLE LANE CONTROLLED BY SIGNALS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces bridge painting work is getting underway this week on two NH Route 103 bridges over the Warner River in the Town of Warner. The two bridges are located within 900 feet of each other.

This bridge painting work will be done one bridge at a time and will require temporary signals to maintain alternating one-way traffic. The work for both bridges will be completed within 60 days and will be suspended to accommodate the Fall Foliage Festival in Warner.

ABHE and Svoboda, Inc. of Prior Lake, Minnesota is the contractor for the \$220,000 project.
