NH ROUTE 101 BRIDGE REPAIRS IN MILFORD AND AMHERST
TWO WEEKS OF JOINT WORK ON THREE BRIDGES

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces bridge repairs are scheduled to begin Tuesday, October 28 on three bridges on NH Route 101 in Milford and Amherst. This work is expected to take two weeks to complete.

This bridge joint repair work will take place on the NH 101 bridge over NH 101A and the Boston and Maine Railroad at the Milford-Amherst town line, and on NH 101 in Amherst over the Souhegan River, and over Thornton's Ferry Road.

Hours for this repair work will be from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm daily, weather permitting. Lane shifts will be necessary in order to complete the work. State Police will be used to help guide motorists through the work zones.
