BERLIN PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
PHASE 2 OF THE NH ROUTE 110 RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces a Public Informational Meeting will be held Thursday, March 19, 2009 in Berlin to review and gather public input on Phase 2 of the NH Route 110 reconstruction project.

This project extends from First Avenue to Wight Street. Alternative 4E, which follows along First Avenue, parallel to the railroad corridor and connects to Wight Street, will be presented. The historic evaluation studies and Alternative 2 will also be reviewed.

This meeting was originally scheduled in February and postponed due to a winter storm. The March 19 public meeting will be held at 6:30 PM at the Berlin City Hall Auditorium, 168 Main Street in Berlin, New Hampshire.

The purposed of this meeting is to present citizens and public officials with information regarding the proposed project, and to solicit pubic input in order to ensure that project decisions meet public transportation needs, community goals, and protect and enhance the environment.
