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INTERSECTION-BRIDGE REPAIR WORK TO BEGIN IN HAVERHILL
IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSECTION OF NH ROUTES 25 AND 10

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces the scheduled start of construction to reconfigure the intersection of NH Route 25 with NH Route 10 in Haverhill from a “Y” intersection to a “T” intersection. This safety improvement is needed to bring the intersection up to current standards and to provide additional room for turning trucks.

This project will also remove the sidewalk along the west side of the bridge carrying NH Route 10 across the Oliverian Brook.

Work is expected to begin on Monday June 29, 2009. One-way alternating traffic at the intersection will be necessary to complete the work. Flaggers will be used to guide motorists through the work zone.

The NHDOT’s Highway Maintenance District 2 and Bureau of Bridge Maintenance will be performing the work.

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
