Type 3 Roadway (Secondary)	ADT	ADT<1,000 (If ADT <500, snow covered roads acceptable)

Type 4 Roadway- As Signed (Primary & Secondary)-Low Salt	ADT	ADT<2,500 (Road may be snow covered)

Type 5 Roadway- As Signed (Secondary)-No Salt	ADT	ADT<1,000 (Road may be snow covered)

General Notes:

- 1) The NHDOT Snow and Ice Policy is based on a snowfall rate of no more than 1"/hour
- 2) Plowing frequency may be extended depending on the rate of snowfall (i.e. storm with a snowfall rate of only 1/4"/hour)
- 3) Plowing frequency may be extended during the hours of 9:00pm - 4:00am
- 4) Type 4 and 5 Roadways are Type 2 and 3 Roadways where a municipality has requested a reduced level of salt application
