RE: S/TIP Minor Revision – January - 2022

Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the January 2022 Minor Revision to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

Regional projects:

- **Brookline (40662)** – NH13 – Construct southbound left turn lane onto Old Milford Road
 - ROW – FFY23 – Decrease in funds.
 - Inflation adjustment
- **Nashua (16314)** - East Hollis Street; Intersection improvements at East Hollis Street and Bridge Street from C Street to the Hudson town line.
 - Construction – FFY 22 – Move FFY 22 to FFY 23.
 - Moved funds based on updated schedule from city.
- **Nashua-Merrimack-Bedford (13761D)** - F. E. Everett Tpk; widening of 2-lane section from north of Exit 13 to north of I-293 diverge
 - Construction – FFY 23 – Increase in funds.
 - Changed based on 2023-2032 GACIT draft Ten Year Plan.
- **Pelham (16145)** – Main Street over Beaver Brook; Bridge replacement (BR. NO. 110/090) and culvert replacements (BR. NO. 111/090).
 - Preliminary Engineering & Construction – FFY23 – Decrease in funds.
 - Inflation adjustment.
- **Wilton-Milford-Amherst-Bedford (13692D)** - NH101; traffic and safety improvements consistent with 2002 Corridor Study.
 - Construction FFY23 & FFY24 – Decrease in funds.
 - Inflation adjustment.


