STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) Update

The STIP is a financially constrained, federally required plan that lists NHDOT projects that are planned to take place within the identified four-year period. The plan contains all federally funded projects as well as those projects that have been identified as regionally significant - regardless of the funding source.
