RE: SNHPC FY 2019 – FY 2022 TIP Administrative Modifications – February 2021

Dear Mr. Watson:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we have approved administrative modifications to the SNHPC FY 2019 - FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). These administrative modifications were reviewed and approved under the expedited TIP revision procedures in the SNHPC Prospectus in response to a request made by your office, which was discussed during the Interagency Consultation meeting held on February 11, 2021.

Specifically, the SNHPC concurs with the revisions listed below for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2022.

- **Program (CRDR)** – Increasing FY 2022 CON funding to reflect anticipated child project expenditures.
- **Program (FTA5307)** – Decreasing FY 2021-2022 OTHER funding to reflect anticipated FTA apportionments and child project expenditures.
- **Program (PAVE-T2-REHAB)** – Decreasing FY 2021 CON funding and increasing FY 2022 CON funding to reflect anticipated child project expenditures.
- **Salem to Manchester (14800B)** – Decreasing FY 2020 CON funding, Increasing FY 2021 CON funding, decreasing FY 2022 CON funding, and updating the funding type to match the current bond model for the project.
- **Statewide TIER 2 (S) (43289)** – Separately listing a programmatic child project to reflect the inclusion of non-participating funding in the FY 2021 PE phase.
