Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the August 2022 Minor Revisions to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

Regional projects:

- **Merrimack (10136D)** NH 101A - Safety improvements at NH 101A / Cont. Blvd & at Craftsman Lane / Boston Post Rd.
 - CONST, FFY2022-2023; Move FFY 22 to FFY 23.
 - Moved funds to align with current design schedule.
- **Nashua-Merrimack-Bedford (13761A)** - FE Everett Turnpike widening of a 2-lane section from Exit 8 (Nashua) to Exit 10 (Merrimack).
 - CONST, FFY2023-2024; Move FFY 23 to FFY 24 & Increase funds.
 - Moved funds to reflect current design schedule.
- **Pelham (41751)** - NH 128 & Sherburne Rd - Intersection improvements at the intersection of NH128 & Sherburne Rd and Mammoth & NH111A.
 - PE, FFY2022-2023; Decrease FFY 22 & add FFY 23.
 - Moved funds to align with current design schedule.
