**RE: S/TIP Minor Revision – January - 2023**

Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the January 2023 Minor Revisions to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

**Regional projects:**

- **Milford (42470)** - NH 101A & NH 13; Improvements to the oval area
  - PE, ROW CON; Move from FFY2023 to FFY2024.
    - Move funds to reflect current design schedule.
- **Nashua (43509)** - Various streets downtown; installation of RRFB's, crosswalk visibility enhancements, & implementation of a road diet on various
  - PE: Increase in funds.
  - ROW: Decrease in funds.
    - Adjust to reflect current costs.
- **Wilton-Milford-Amherst-Bedford (13692E)** - Traffic and safety improvements based on the 2002 NH 101 corridor study.
  - PE: Decrease funds
    - Inflation adjustment (first estimate in FFY2023).

**Statewide & Programmatic Projects**

PROGRAM (BRDG-T1/2-M&P) -Tier 1-2 Bridges; Maintenance & preservation of tier 1 & 2 bridges.

PROGRAM (BRDG-T3/4-M&P) - Tier 3-4 Bridges; Maintenance and preservation of tier 3 & 4 bridges.

PROGRAM (HSIP) – Various; Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

PROGRAM (MTA5307) – Manchester Transit Authority (MTA); MTA operating, ADA, capital PM, planning utilizing FTA Section 5307 funds. Includes CART area.


PROGRAM (PAVE-T2-RESURF) – Tier 2 Highways; Resurfacing Tier 2 Roadways.

PROGRAM (TA) – Various; Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP).

STATEWIDE (43932) – Various; Construct Vehicle Classification Stations and Vehicle Count Stations for Traffic Data Collection.
