RE: S/TIP Minor Revision – July - 2022

Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the July 2022 Minor Revisions to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

Regional projects:

- **Nashua (10136A)** - NASHUA - NH 101A; Widening of NH 101A from Somerset Pkwy to Celina Ave.
 - PE, FFY2022-2024 - Remove FFY 22, Decrease FFY 23, Add FFY 24.
 - Move funding to align with anticipated project schedule.
 - ROW, FFY2022-2024 - Remove FFY 23, Increase FFY 24 & change in funding type.
 - Funding type adjusted to better align with available federal funding & moved funds to align with the anticipated project schedule.
- **Nashua (43509)** - Various streets downtown; Installation of RRFB's, crosswalk visibility enhancements & implementation of a road diet on various.
 - PE, FFY2022-2023 - Decrease FFY 22 & Add FFY 23.
 - Funding type adjusted to better align with available federal funding & moved funds to align with the anticipated project schedule.
- **PROGRAM (NTS 5307)** – Nashua Transit System; FTA 5307 Formula Funds for Capital Planning, Preventative Maintenance, ADA & Operating Assistance
 - OTHER, 2022-2024 - Increase in funds
 - The program is being adjusted to accommodate necessary changes in children project fund amounts.
- **PROGRAM (NTS 5339)** – Nashua Transit System; FTA 5339 Formula Funds for Bus & Bus Related Equipment & Facilities Capital Projects
 - OTHER, 2022-2024 - Increase FFY22 funds, decrease FFY23 & 24 funds.
 - The program is being adjusted to accommodate necessary changes in children project fund amounts.

Statewide & Programmatic Projects

PROGAM (BRDG-T3/4-MP) – Tier 3-4 Bridges; Maintenance & preservation of tier 3 & 4 bridges.

PROGRAM (FTA 5307) – Boston Urbanized Area (UZA); Boston Urbanized Area (UZA) FTA Section 5307 apportioned funds for NHDOT transit projects.

PROGRAM (FTA 5310) – Various; Capital, Mobility Management, and Operating for Seniors & Individuals w/ Disabilities - FTA 5310 Program.


PROGRAM (FTA5311) – Various; Nonurbanized Area (Rural) formula program - FTA Section 5311 Program.

PROGRAM (FTA5339) – Various; Capital bus and bus facilities - FTA 5339 Program for statewide public transportation.

PROGRAM (PAVE-T2-RESURF) - Tier 2 Highways: Resurfacing Tier 2 Roadways

STATEWIDE (43104) – Various; Underwater Bridge Inspection for years from 2021 to 2023.
