Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the June 2022 Minor Revision to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

Regional projects:

- **Amherst (41413)** - NH122; Address red list bridge carrying NH122 (Main St) over NH101 in the Town of Amherst (135/109).
 - Construction; Decrease in funds & Funding participation change in FY2022
 - Decreasing funds currently needed, & Funding participation updated to show correct match type.
- **Milford (42470)** - NH 101A & NH 13; Improvements to the oval area.
 - PE; move from FY 2022-2023
 - Moved funds to align with current design schedule.
 - ROW & Construction; Decrease in funds in FY2023
 - Inflation adjustment.
- **Nashua (40660)** - East Hollis St; Improvements along East Hollis Street from Main Street east to C Street (limit of project 16314).
 - PE; Move from FFY22 to FFY23
 - Moved funds to align with current design schedule.
 - ROW; Decrease in funds in FY2024
 - Inflation adjustment.
- **Nashua (13761A)** - FE Everett Turnpike; FE Everett Turnpike widening of a 2-lane section from Exit 8 (Nashua) to Exit 10 (Merrimack).
 - Construction; Decrease in funds in FY2023-2024
 - Inflation adjustment.

PROGRAM (BRDG HIP M&P) – Various.


PROGRAM (RCTRL) – Various - RECREATIONAL TRAILS FUND ACT- projects selected annually.
