**RE: S/TIP Minor Revision – November - 2022**

Dear Mr. Watson:

The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the November 2022 Minor Revisions to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

**Regional projects:**

- **Amherst (40657)** - Thornton Ferry Road over Beaver Brook; Bridge Replacement-Thornton Ferry Road over Beaver Brook-Br. #145/106.
  - PE – Increase in FFY 2023 funds
    - New MOBIL Project, increase is to SA funds
- **Merrimack (10136D)** NH 101A; Safety improvements at NH 101A / Cont. Blvd & at Craftsman Lane / Boston Post Rd.
  - CONSTRUCTION – Change in funding type
    - Funding type adjusted to better align with available federal funding.

**Statewide & Programmatic Projects**

PROGRAM (ADA) – Various; Upgrades to side walks, curb ramps, and signals to be compliant with ADA laws.

PROGRAM (BRDG-T1/2 – M&P) -Various; Tier 1-2 Bridges, Maintenance & preservation of tier 1 & 2 bridges.

PROGRAM (BRDG-T3/4 – M&P) -Various; Tier 3-4 Bridges, Maintenance & preservation of tier 3 & 4 bridges.

PROGRAM (HSIP) – Various; Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

PROGRAM (PAVE-T2-RESURF) - Tier 2 Highways; Resurfacing Tier 2 Roadways.


PROGRAM (PVMRK) – Various; Statewide Pavement Marking Annual Project.

PROGRAM (TA) – Various; Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP).

STATEWIDE (43931) – I-393, I-95, I-93, I-89; Construct Weigh-in-Motion Stations for Traffic Data Collection.
