The Nashua Regional Planning Commission (NRPC) Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has considered the request to approve the October 2021 Minor Revision to the adopted Nashua Metropolitan Area 2021 – 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The proposed revisions to the projects meet the requirements of the Nashua MPO expedited project selection procedures.

NRPC concurs with the proposed Minor Revisions to the various Regional, Programmatic and Statewide projects for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024 that are listed below.

Regional projects:

- **Amherst (41413)** – NH122; Address red list bridge carrying NH122 (Main St) over NH101 in the Town of Amherst (135/109).
 - CONSTRUCTION – FFY21 – Decrease in funds
 - Decrease is due to more accurate bid list, project advertises on 9/7/2021
- **Milford (42470)** - NH101A/NH13; Improvements to the Oval area.
 - PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING – FFY2021 – Decrease in funds
 - Funds not needed in FFY2021
 - PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING – FFY2022 – Decrease in funds
 - Inflation Adjustment
 - ROW – FFY 2023 – Decrease in Funds
 - Inflation adjustment
 - CONSTRUCTION – FFY 2023 - Decrease in funds
 - Inflation adjustment

Statewide & Programmatic Projects:

PROGRAM (PAVE-T1-RESURF) – TIER 1 Highways – Resurface Tier 1 Highways.

PROGRAM (TA) – Various – Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP).

PROGRAM (UBI) – Various – Underwater Bridge Inspection (Annual Project).

STATEWIDE SIGNALS (42878) – Various – Upgrades to 10 locations statewide that may include flashing yellow arrow and optimized signal timing.
