September Minor Revisions

- William Rose noted that the September report had a number of newly added minor revisions due to the end of the federal fiscal year and federal funding redistribution to New Hampshire.
- Linda Dusenberry advised that the Clean Air Act code for the Nashua-Manchester 40818 project (i.e. Capitol Corridor) has been updated from "ATT" to E-34.
- There were no additional questions or comments on the September minor revisions.

Agency Updates

- Eric Rackauskas reported that preliminary planning is underway for the next Northern Transportation and Air Quality Summit, which is expected to be a virtual event.
- Tim White reported that seven (7) projects have been identified for the FY 2019 State Clean Diesel Program. The FY 2020 solicitation for the State Clean Diesel Program is expected to be announced this fall.
- Leigh Levine advised that he recently sent a reminder e-mail to interagency partners regarding air quality conformity requirements, and that message included an approved template for conducting a planning-level air quality conformity analysis.
- Leigh Levine noted that the FHWA upcoming Value Capture Virtual Peer Exchange is scheduled for September 24th at 1:00 PM.
- Leigh Levine noted that the next "Talking Freight" seminar is scheduled for September 16th at 1:00 PM.

Other Business

- Fred Butler reported that the next solicitation of FTA Section 5305(e) funding (Statewide Transit Planning and Research) will be announced in the November/December timeframe, and advised that RPCs begin coordinating with their transit providers to identify potential projects.
